Marian Hill to Speak on Judicial Appointments



Koch Tentacles Reach Deep into LD11 and Tucson

It is hard work to trace all the connections between the billionaire Koch Brothers, their donor network and their acolytes. The influence is hidden in hundreds of benign sounding organizations such as the Center for the Philosophy of Freedom at UA (Freedom Center), Americans for Prosperity, FAIR (Fair and Independent Redistricting) and American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC). Which one of us is not for freedom, prosperity, fairness and exchanging ideas? Unfortunately all these organizations have been established to advance the Koch agenda of unregulated markets, climate change denying, limited taxation, pro-school voucher, anti-alternative energy and voter suppression in our State.

In LD11 they have worked through Representative Finchem to propose HB2002 to allow for the firing of teachers if they teach "controversial" topics which for the Kochs would be climate change, evolution and social justice. Senator Leach has consistently received high ratings from Americans for Prosperity, filed a failed lawsuit against the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission, and has recently been appointed to the Tax and Fiscal Policy Task Force of ALEC when he was elected to do what is best for us.

The University of Arizona Center for the Philosophy of Freedom pushed a textbook to TUSD and two other school districts which they claim teaches Ethics, Economy and Entrepreneurship but instead preaches greed as good and government intervention as bad even to mitigate disasters such as Hurricane Katrina. Academics associated with the Freedom Center have gone on to write books such as *Against Democracy* by Jason Brennan which justifies voter suppression.

With the 2020 election fast approaching it is crucial that we become familiar with the Kochopus so we can successfully fight its growing influence. Further the 2020 Census will precipitate new redistricting. Our Koch funded Governor and Koch representatives are already trying to find way to subvert the Commission. We must remain vigilant.
